

COST OF ATTENDANCE

When determining financial aid eligibility, a Cost of Attendance (COA) is established. The Financial Aid Office determines an estimated amount for the cost of attendance at Patrick & Henry Community College (P&HCC), as mandated by the U.S. Department of Education.

The COA is comprised of direct and indirect costs. Direct costs to attend P&HCC includes your tuition, fees and book expenses. Indirect costs include estimated living expenses, transportation and personal expenses.

There are three COAs for students attending P&HCC, dependent student, independent student and out-of-state student.

Enrollment levels:

Full-time: 12+ credits/per semester

¾ time: – 9 – 11 credits/per semester

½ time: 6-8 credits/per semester

Less ½ time: 1-5 credits/per semester
