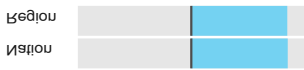

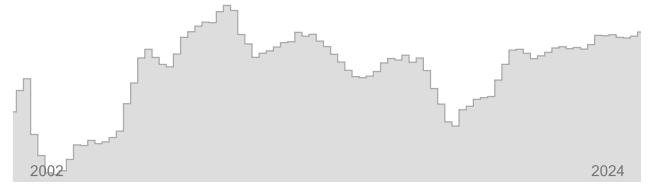

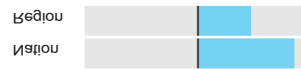

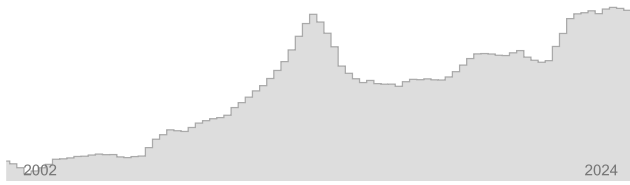

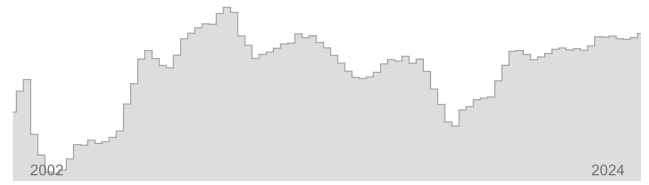

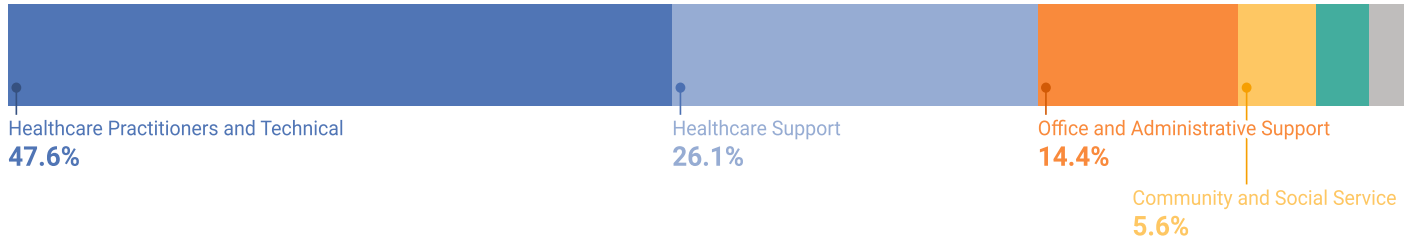

- 💡 Employment is one of the broadest and most timely measures of a region’s economy. Fluctuations in the number of jobs shed light on the health of an industry. A growing employment base creates more opportunities for regional residents and helps a region grow its population.
- 💡 Since wages and salaries generally compose the majority of a household’s income, the annual average wages of a region affect its average household income, housing market, quality of life, and other socioeconomic indicators.

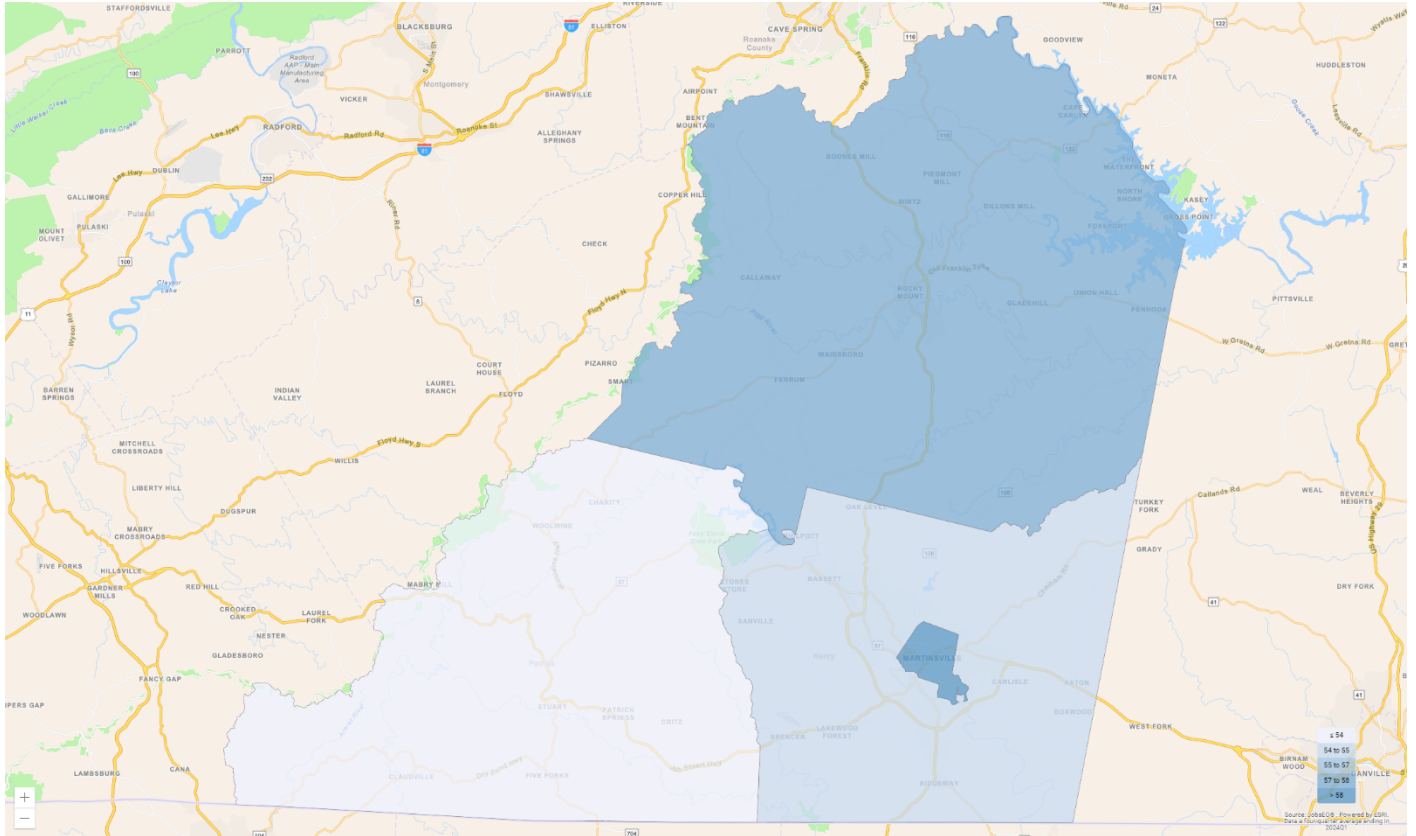

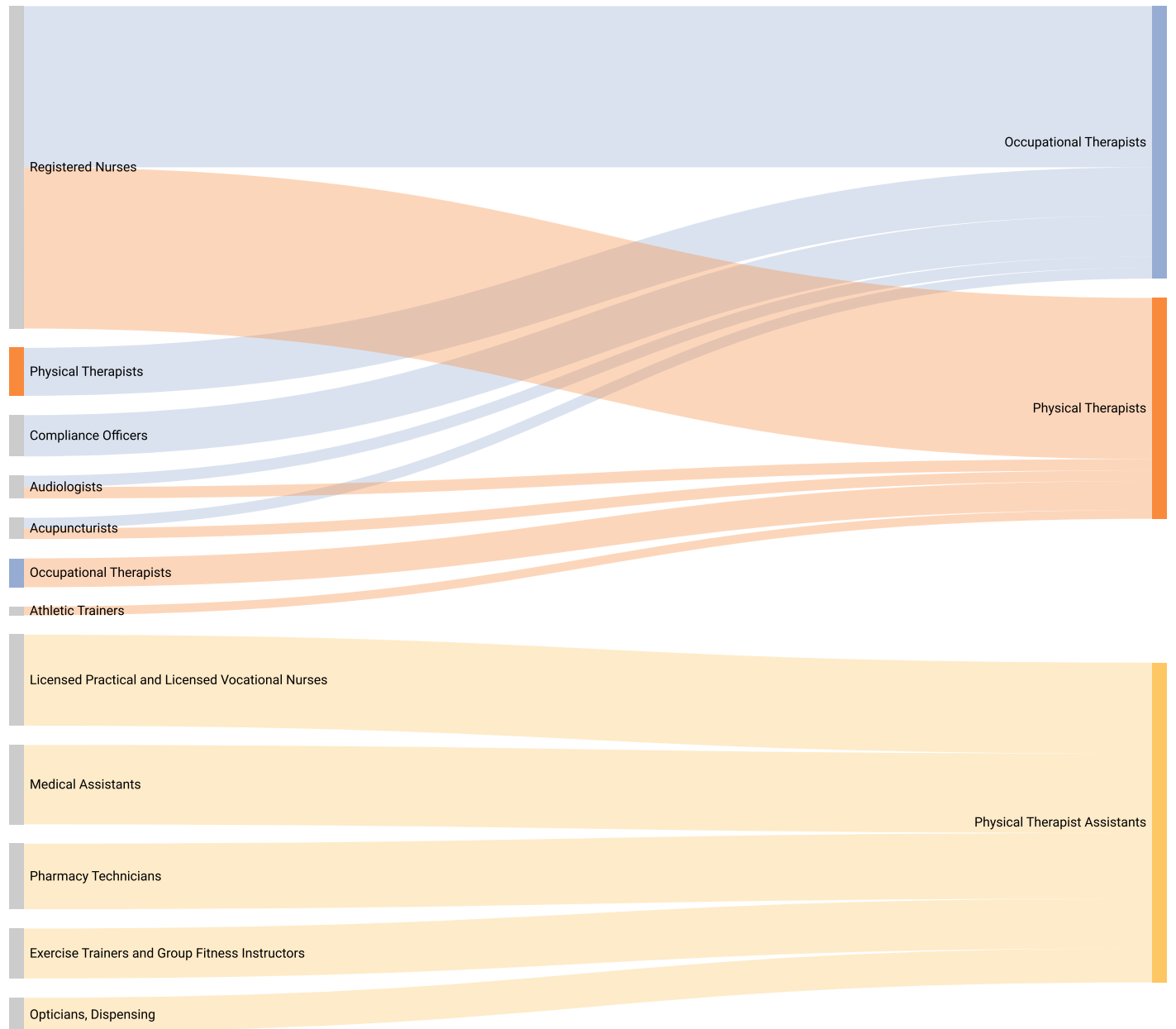
