☐ COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THE APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

It's free, and it only takes about 15 minutes to complete. Start Here.

☐ EXPLORE FINANCIAL AID

Afraid you can't afford college? At P&HCC, we believe no one should miss out on a college education because they think they can't afford it. Scholarships, grants and loans make a great education even more affordable. To receive <u>Financial Aid</u>, you'll need to start planning early and make sure all forms are turned in on time. To help you get started, we've broken the process down into three easy steps:

STEP ONE: Fill out a FAFSA.

The first step in applying for financial aid is completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, you'll hear it called FAFSA. The FAFSA must be completed each year. Get help completing the FAFSA here.

STEP TWO: Apply for Scholarships

Now that you've applied for Federal Financial Aid, it's not required, but it's always a good idea to apply for additional <u>scholarships</u> that are offered through P&HCC, the state, and other agencies, and that don't have to be repaid.

STEP THREE: Check your status and awards

Make sure you haven't missed anything. For some students additional paperwork is needed. It's important to <u>visit your myP&HCC-Student Information</u> and check your To-Do List to make sure you've got everything taken care of. If there is nothing for you to do, you can use that page to review your awards. Just remember that if more documents are needed, you won't be eligible for federal aid until they are turned in and processed.

STEP THREE: ACCESS YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT AND SET-UP MFA (Multi-Factor Authentication)

Your P&HCC username and password is provided during the application process, please use those to login to the site. Students accessing their myP&HCC accounts for the first time, should create a password before setting-up-MFA. MFA adds a layer of security to online accounts by requiring you to verify that you are who you say you are. This account will give you access to your Student Information System (SIS) (registration, payments, financial aid, grades, graduation application etc.), e-mail, and CANVAS (any online courses you enroll in.) Please note that you will not have access to your student email account until after you have registered for classes.

☐ STEP FOUR: CONNECT WITH AN ADVISOR AND REGISTER FOR CLASSES.
